

Will our Prophet intercede?

When the Quran says the Prophet ﷺ will intercede for only those whom Allah wills. -- 21:28/ 20:109

One who calls other than Allah, his deeds will be accounted as nil. -- 39: 65

How frustrating to see that people are still in the illusion,

That whatever they do, they can get intercession,

That they will be redeemed from all their sins

If they pray for the help of the Prophet ﷺ, and those Auliya akin.

They think their wishes will be fulfilled,

By just going to the Mazars, painted and grilled

We find that their imaginations have gone berserk

When they concentrate on praying to the Prophet, thus causing Shirk.

He ﷺ says: Indeed, for Allah, is my Sala'at, service, my life, and my death— 6: 162

HE alone can guide me through the straight path till the end of my breath. — 6: 163

I am only a warner to you and do not know the unseen,

Without HIS permission, I cannot intercede with Allah for you, on the day of Deen.

Only after Allah points out the person can I intercede

Nothing against Allah's decision can anyone precede.

To Allah belongs all intercession, and if you join others as partners, -- 39: 44

All your deeds will be in vain, and you will be among the losers. -- 39: 65

Allah tells HIS prophet ﷺ to say: "...do not pray to ME for those wrongdoers"-

"Truly, Hell is a place of anguish for the transgressors." --(78: 21,23)

Our Prophet ﷺ will be reclining in Barzakh, like a bridegroom,

Do you think he will be made to hear all our tales of gloom?

Even on the DAY, he will not answer or intercede for those who disobey.

So, what our Prophet ﷺ has said, let us try to obey.

He ﷺ strove all his life to teach this doctrine of Tawheed.

How painful it would be for him when he knows that we have paid no heed

Allah says: Do not despair of Allah's Mercy. Hence be to HIM dutiful, -- 39: 53

And, turn in repentance. Verily, HE is all-forgiving and Merciful. -- 39: 54

Follow our Prophet ﷺ and what has been sent to him in the Quran, - 33: 21

Which shows clearly the difference between Right and wrong- the Furqan'

TO Worship Allah Alone, be righteous, and put your trust in HIM Alone.

This will give you peace of mind, and to heavenly bliss you will be borne.
